The Community First Responder Scheme.

The Community First Responder (CFR) scheme is a partnership between Yorkshire Ambulance Service (YAS) NHS Trust and local groups of volunteers within their community.



Authorised volunteers for YAS work as part of a dedicated team of volunteers whose aim is to **reduce the number of pre-**

hospital deaths in Yorkshire. It is not always possible, to get an emergency vehicle to a patient with a potentially life-threatening condition within the first few vital minutes.

Community First Responders Help Save Lives by providing effective treatment within those first few minutes. This is especially true for heart attacks and medical conditions that have caused someone to lose consciousness.



Community First Responders are trained in basic life support skills, the use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) and to administer oxygen.



When an emergency call is received at the YAS 999 Communications Centre, an ambulance response is dispatched. At the same time a Community First Responder, on-call in the area, can be alerted and asked to assist at the 999 incident

to ensure emergency assistance reaches the patient as quickly as possible. More than 275,000 people suffer a heart attack in the UK each year, about a third of whom die before reaching hospital due to cardiac arrest. The defibrillators carried by Community First Responders provide early intervention to patients suffering a cardiac arrest which is one of the keys to survival.

Our raffle this year is to help support our local First Response team working in Bramley, Armley, Wortley and Pudsey.


